

Student added words to the performance that weren't in the original script, not in the introduction and not used as transitional language: "hash tag something" was used multiple times during the performance.

Action Taken:

Mckinley High School's coach, Helen Chang, verified that the words "hash tag" and "swag" were included in the presentation for reasons not related to transitioning. According to the National Forensic League Competition Events Guide, "Adaptations to material may only be used for the purpose of transition" ("Interpretation," Section 5 "Performance," Pt. 1, p. 19). Under Section XIX "Penalties" of the Hawaii Speech League (HSL) Handbook, "Doctoring or altering interpretation texts beyond occasional cosmetic alteration necessary for a smooth cutting" (p. 17) is considered an unethical behavior with which the sanction of disqualification is associated. The HSL Executive Board decided that the words "hash tag" and "swag" included for reasons other than transitions fell under this violation. Therefore, competitor 14H9 was disqualified from the tournament.
